

From the desk of the Staff Judge Advocate, 4th Fighter Wing:
The following military justice and administrative actions completed in **the first quarter of 2022.**

COURTS-MARTIAL

A **Staff Sergeant** from the 4th Maintenance Group was found guilty at a General Court-Martial for committing abusive sexual contact on another Airman. The **Staff Sergeant's** sentence consisted of confinement for 24 months, a bad conduct discharge, total forfeitures, and a reduction in grade to E-1.

A **Senior Airman** from the 4th Munitions Squadron was found guilty at a Summary Court-Martial for assaulting two of his co-workers while on duty. The **Senior Airman's** sentence consisted of 30 days confinement, a reduction to E-1, and a reprimand.

An **Airman** from the 4th Logistics Readiness Squadron was found guilty at a Summary Court-Martial for Tetrahydrocannabinol (Delta-8 and Delta-9) use. The **Airman's** sentence consisted of 22 days confinement, a reduction to E-1, and a reprimand.

NONJUDICIAL PUNISHMENT UNDER ARTICLE 15, UCMJ

Nonjudicial punishment under Article 15, UCMJ, provides commanders with an essential and prompt means of maintaining good order and discipline and/or promote positive behavior changes in servicemembers.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Force Support Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Marijuana Use and Possession and Dereliction of Duty. The Airman First Class's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman Basic, Forfeiture of \$916.00 per month for one month, and a reprimand.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Component Maintenance Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Marijuana Use. The Airman First Class's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman, 14 days Extra duty, and reprimand.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Medical Group accepted an Article 15 for Dereliction of Duty. The Airman First Class's punishment included forfeiture of \$1,148.00 per month for two months, suspended through 3 July 2022, 15 days Extra duty and a reprimand.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Force Support Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Wrongful Use of Tetrahydrocannabinol. The Airman First Class's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman, Forfeiture of \$1,000.00 per month for 2 months, suspended through 17 May 2022, and a reprimand.

A **Staff Sergeant** from the 4th Logistics Readiness Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Drunkenness. The Staff Sergeant's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Senior Airman, with new date of rank of 25 October 2021, Forfeiture of \$1,250.00 pay per month for 2 months, 5 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

A **Master Sergeant** from the 4th Force Support Squadron accepted an Article 15 for False Official Statements. The Master Sergeant's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Technical

Sergeant, suspended through 17 April 2022, Forfeiture of \$2,148.00 pay per month for 2 months, and a reprimand.

A **Senior Airman** from the 4th Civil Engineer Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Missing a Movement, Failure to Go, and False Official Statement. The Senior Airman's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, suspended through 27 July 2022, forfeiture of \$217.00 pay per month for two months, and a reprimand.

An **Airman** from the 4th Logistics Readiness Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Assault Consummated by Battery and Failure to Go. The Airman's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman Basic, with new date of rank of 1 February 2022, forfeiture of \$916.00 pay per month for one month, suspended through 30 July 2022, and a reprimand.

An **Airman** from the 4th Munitions Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Wrongful Use of Delta-8 THC. The Airman's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman Basic, with new date of rank of 11 February 2022 and a reprimand.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Component Maintenance Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Failure to Go and False Official Statements. The Airman First Class's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman, with new date of rank of 8 November 2021, forfeiture of \$250.00 pay per month for 2 months, suspended through 7 May 2022, 10 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Logistics Readiness Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Domestic Violence. The Airman First Class's punishment included a reduction the grade of Airman, suspended through 4 May 2022 and a reprimand.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Logistics Readiness Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Destruction of Military Property and Dereliction of Duty. The Airman First Class's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman, with new date of rank of 27 December and a reprimand.

A **Senior Airman** from the 4th Equipment Maintenance Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Wrongful Use of Delta-8 THC. The Senior Airman's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, with new date of rank of 23 February 2022, forfeiture of \$216 pay per month for 2 months, suspended through 22 August 2022, 10 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

A **Senior Airman** from the 4th Munitions Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Dereliction of Duty: Sexual Harassment. The Senior Airman's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, with new date of rank of 1 December 2021, 14 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

A **Senior Airman** from the 333rd Fighter Generation Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Dereliction of Duty. The Senior Airman's punishment included a reduction the grade of Airman First Class, suspended through 14 June 2022, 35 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

A **Staff Sergeant** from the 333rd Fighter Generation Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Dereliction of Duty. The Staff Sergeant's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Senior Airman, suspended through 2 July 2022, 31 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

A **Staff Sergeant** from the 4th Operations Support Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Wrongful Use of Tetrahydrocannabinol. The Staff Sergeant's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Senior Airman, with new date of rank of 7 December 2021 and a reprimand.

A **Technical Sergeant** from the 336th Fighter Generation Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Assault Consummated by Battery and Indecent Conduct. The Technical Sergeant's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Staff Sergeant, with new date of rank of 15 November 2021, Forfeiture of \$1,702.00 pay per month for 2 months, 30 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

A **Senior Airman** from the 33th6 Fighter Generation Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Wrongful Use of Delta-8 THC. The Senior Airman's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, with new date of rank of 1 March 2022 and a reprimand.

A **Senior Airman** from the 4th Equipment Maintenance Squadron accepted an Article 15 for Wrongful Use of Delta-8 THC. The Senior Airman's punishment included a reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, with new date of rank of 23 February 2022, forfeiture of \$216 pay per month for 2 months, suspended through 22 August 2022, 10 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

ADMINISTRATIVE DISCHARGES

Commanders and supervisors identify members who show a likelihood for early separation and make reasonable efforts to help these members meet Air Force standards. Members who do not show potential for future service should be discharged.

A **Captain** from the 336th Fighter Squadron was discharged for serious or recurring misconduct punishable by military or civilian authorities. The Capt was separated with a General (under honorable conditions) service characterization.

An **Airman First Class** from the 333rd Fighter Generation Squadron was discharged for Misconduct: Drug Abuse (Delta-8 THC). The Airman First Class was separated with a General (under honorable conditions) service characterization.

A **Senior Airman** from the 4th Equipment Maintenance Squadron was discharged for Misconduct: Drug Abuse (Delta-9 THC). The Senior Airman was separated with a General (under honorable conditions) service characterization.

An **Airman Basic** from the 4th Munitions Squadron was discharged for Misconduct: Drug Abuse (Delta-8 THC). The Airman Basic was separated with a General (under honorable conditions) service characterization.

An **Airman** from the 4th Component Maintenance Squadron was discharged for Misconduct: Drug Abuse (Delta-9 THC). The Airman was separated with a General (under honorable conditions) service characterization.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Munitions Squadron was discharged for Misconduct: Minor Disciplinary Infractions. The Airman First Class was separated with a General (under honorable conditions) service characterization.

An **Airman First Class** from the 4th Equipment Maintenance Squadron was discharged for Misconduct: Minor Disciplinary Infractions. The Airman First Class was separated with a General (under honorable conditions) service characterization.

A **Senior Airman** from the 334th Fighter Generation Squadron was discharged for Misconduct: Pattern of Misconduct. The Senior Airman was separated with a General (under honorable conditions) service characterization.

A **Senior Airman** from the 4th Logistics Readiness Squadron was discharged for a Mental Health Condition that Interferes with Military Service. The Senior Airman was separated with an Honorable service characterization.

A **Senior Airman** from the 4th Civil Engineering Squadron was discharged for a Mental Health Condition that Interferes with Military Service. The Senior Airman was separated with an Honorable service characterization.

ADMINISTRATIVE DEMOTIONS

An administrative demotion is a quality force management tool commanders have to help ensure a quality enlisted force. Administrative demotions are intended to place Airmen at a rank commensurate with their skill level and ability.

A **Senior Airman** of the 4th Munitions Squadron was demoted to Airman First Class after being caught driving while intoxicated.

A **Senior Airman** of the 4th Component Maintenance Squadron was demoted to Airman First Class after being caught driving while intoxicated.

A **Staff Sergeant** of the 4th Force Support Squadron was demoted to Senior Airman after being caught driving while intoxicated.

A **Senior Airman** of the 4th Logistics Readiness Squadron was demoted to Airman First Class after being caught driving while intoxicated.

An **Airman First Class** of the 4th Munitions Squadron was demoted to Airman after failing three official fitness assessments in a row.
