BUYERS BILL OF RIGHTS

- 1. To be treated as an adult about to spend thousands of dollars, WITH RESPECT.
- 2. To request and be truthfully informed about the history and condition of the vehicle.
- 3. To know the asking price and fair market value of the vehicle.
- 4. To request and receive before signing the dealer completed Buyers Order and financing agreement.
- 5. To use the Buyer's Order and financing agreement to shop for the best rate of finance.
- 6. To never sign a promissory note for a financed purchase.
- 7. To test drive and take used vehicles to a mechanic for a diagnostic evaluation prior to purchase.
- 8. To not have to stay for hours at the dealership when making a purchase.
- 9. To have the sale be final when the contracts are signed and you have been told you are financed.
- 10. To not have to waive your rights to sue a bad dealer with a binding mandatory arbitration clause or waiver.
