Captain (Dr.) Cody J. Christensen is currently serving as a General Dentist, 4th Aerospace Medicine Squadron, 4th Medical Group, Seymour Johnson AFB. As a staff dentist at the Kiecker Dental Clinic, Dr. Christensen provides dental care to over two thousand active duty beneficiaries covering over 4800 procedures annually. As a general dentist with advanced training, Dr. Christensen delivers a diverse scope of care with a primary focus in providing oral surgery services to beneficiaries. He is also capable of providing care in endodontics, fixed and removable prosthodontics, limited orthodontics, restorative dentistry and preventive services. In the dental clinic, he directly oversees the Infection Control program, the Medical Emergencies program, and the Intravenous Sedation program. He is also a member of the 4th MDG Triage Team.



Captain Christensen commissioned into the Air Force in June 2009 after being accepted into the Air Force Health Professions Scholarship Program. He acted as a reservist while receiving his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree at the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry in Oklahoma City, OK. In November 2012, he was accepted into the Advanced Education in General Dentistry residency program at Nellis Air Force Base, NV and began his active duty service in July 2013. In July 2015, he was selected into the highly competitive Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery residency program at Lackland AFB and will begin training in July 2017.

Captain Christensen is originally from Garland, UT and is married to Rachelle Christensen (née Loiseau) from Lehi UT. They have one daughter named Sadie and twin boys name Cole and Crew.
