



***Did you know...***

That the A&FRC offers a “CHILD CARE FOR PCS” program?

The Air Force Aid Society will pay up to **20 hours** of child care (per child) for parents in the midst of a PCS move. Families with PCS orders can obtain a certificate from the A&FRC at both their outgoing and incoming bases. The certificates can be used within 60 days prior to departure and 60 days after arrival at the new base. This program is open to all ranks. Contact the A&FRC for more information!

That the A&FRC has a “LOAN CLOSET”?

If you are waiting for household goods to arrive or have shipped yours out already...or you are TDY... or simply have out of town guests, the Loan Closet at the A&FRC can provide you with loaner items to make your life easier. Loaners are available to active duty, retired or civilian personnel.



Loan closet items include dishes, bake ware, cookware, electrical appliances such as microwaves, irons, alarm clocks, baby items (high chair, car seat, pack-n-play, futons, folding tables, folding chairs and much more.
